## Silent Auction of Small Quilts

Quilts and other items for the Silent Auction may be delivered at the Guild meetings or delivered directly to Silent Auction Committee Co-Chairs, Connie Richman or Greta Keverline. Items for the Silent Auction will also be accepted on Quilt take-in day, July 13th, 2010 at our guild meeting.

### Guidelines:

1. The Silent Auction accepts only new items made by FCQG members. See our website at [www.fourcountyquilters.com](http://www.fourcountyquilters.com) for a membership application.
2. Please complete a separate registration for each item.
3. The Silent Action is primarily miniature, small quilts and wall hangings. Pillows, clothing, stuffed animals, purses, table runners, placemats, Christmas stockings, and other quilted items are also accepted.
4. A "Minimum Bid" will be set by the committee members with input of estimated value by maker.
5. The Silent Auction will offer a "Buy it Now" price where a bidder may purchase the item at the established "Buy it Now" price and take it with them. This price will be decided upon by the Silent Auction Committee and may be triple or quadruple the minimum bid.
6. Please provide a photo of your item to be used in the bid book. Photos should be approximately 4 inches by 6 inches.
